



LICENSE AGREEMENT

Under this Agreement, the Author(s) grant(s) specific rights to the Journal, subject to the following clauses, which are applicable based on the individual and collective status of the Author(s) as government employees of any country in the world:

- (1) Material created by US Federal Government employees in the course of their employment is not subject to copyright, and therefore, the license does not apply. However, the Author Warranties stated in this Agreement will still apply.
- (2) Material created by employees of the UK Crown in the course of their employment shall automatically be granted a non-exclusive license as provided by this Agreement.

Grant of Rights

1.1 The Author(s) hereby grants to the Journal an exclusive, worldwide, and royalty-bearing license to publish (i.e., print, publish, sell and otherwise commercially exploit), reproduce, distribute, publicly display, and store the Article in print, electronic, and any other format or medium now known or hereafter developed, including digital platforms, databases, and online repositories.

1.2 The Author(s) acknowledge(s) that the Journal may sublicense the rights granted under this Agreement to third parties, including but not limited to indexing services, abstracting and citation databases, and other similar entities.

Manuscript Preparation and Delivery

2.1 The Author(s) shall prepare the Article in accordance with the Journal's guidelines and formatting requirements as provided by the Journal.

2.2 The Author(s) shall deliver the final version of the Article, including any supplementary materials, to the Journal in the format specified by the Journal. The Author(s) shall ensure the accuracy and completeness of the Article and any accompanying materials.



Editing and Production

3.1 The Journal may, at its discretion, make editorial changes to the Article to ensure clarity, coherence, and adherence to the Journal's publication standards. The Journal shall make reasonable efforts to consult with the Author(s) regarding substantial changes to the Article.

3.2 The Journal shall have the right to design, typeset, and produce the Article in its chosen format, including but not limited to cover design, layout, and pagination.

User Rights

4.1 The Journal shall publish the Article in the journal on its online platforms under an Open Access basis, applying the **Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial 4.0 International License** (CC BY-NC 4.0 <https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc/4.0/>) to the Article. In the event that the article is mandated to be published in the public domain, the Author shall notify the Journal at the time of submission, and the article shall be released under the Creative Commons 1.0 Public Domain Dedication waiver (<https://creativecommons.org/publicdomain/zero/1.0/>)

Copyright

5.1 The Author(s) retain(s) the copyright in the Article subject to the rights granted to the Journal under this Agreement.

5.2 The Journal shall prominently display appropriate copyright notices on all published versions of the Article, indicating the Author(s) as the copyright owner(s) and the year of first publication.

Reversion of Rights

6.1 If the Journal determines, at its sole discretion, that it will not publish the Article, it shall notify the Author(s) in writing within a reasonable time. In such case, all rights granted to the Journal under this Agreement shall revert to the Author(s).

Representations and Warranties

7.1 The Author(s) represent(s) and warrant(s) that:

- a) The Article is original and does not infringe upon any copyright, trademark, or other intellectual property rights of any third party.
- b) The Author(s) have the full power and authority to enter into this Agreement and grant the rights herein.
- c) The Article has not been previously published, or is currently under consideration for publication elsewhere, including any versions in languages other than English, and the Author(s) have not entered into any other agreement that conflicts with the rights granted to the Journal under this Agreement.
- d) The Article does not contain any defamatory, libelous, or unlawful content, and does not violate the privacy rights of any individual or entity.
- e) The Author(s) has(have) made substantial contributions to the study design, data collection or analysis, intellectual content editing, or manuscript writing, which sufficiently justifies authorship credit for this publication.
- f) The Article complies with known scientific and publication ethical standards.
- g) If, during the peer-review process, additional relevant data are requested, the Author(s) will comply with the request.

9.1 This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Hong Kong. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Hong Kong.
